




#### NHPSA Family has made a World Record

It was certified by OMG Book of World Records












Our students who appeared for AISSE and AISSCE passed out in flying colours and made the school proud by their outstanding performance.



# Periodic Assessment I for grade III - X was conducted in the month of June.


Periodic assessments are conducted to monitor students progress over time.
