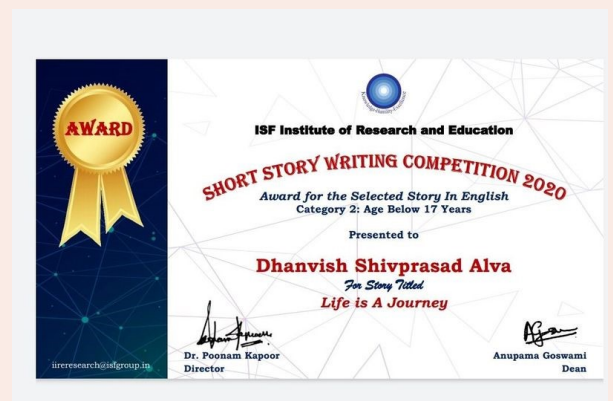
Aspiring Writer: Harshita in 15 finalist of Nanhi Chhaan

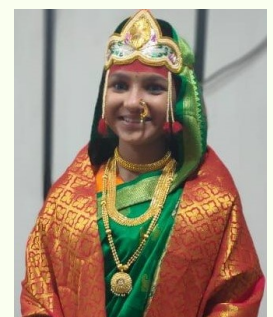

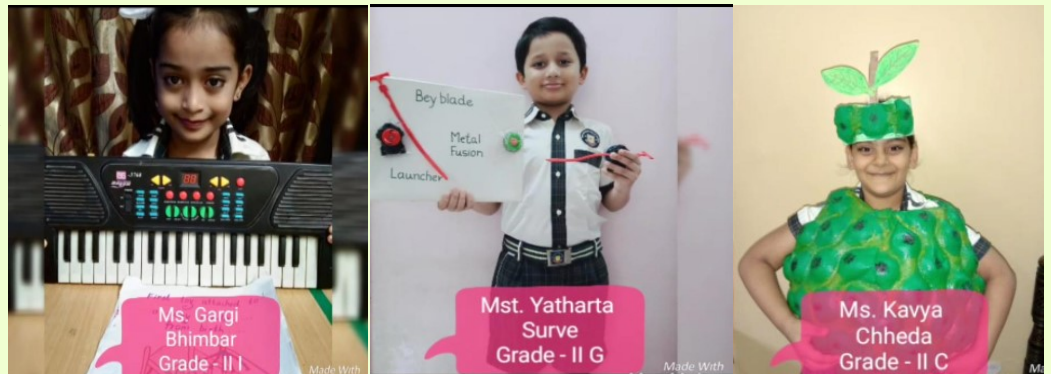

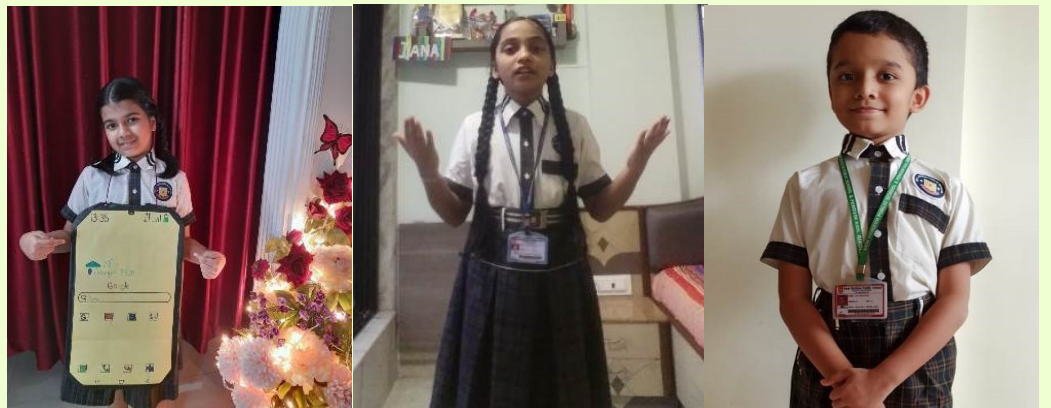
