MASK is an object normally worn on the face, typically for protection, disguise, performance, or entertainment. The etymology of the word mask is from the French "masque" -a covering to hide or guard the face. The ancient latin word for mask is "persona", which literally indicates "false face" – an aspect of personality shown to or perceived by others. 


Aspiring Writer: Harshita in 15 finalist of Nanhi Chhaan

Dhanvish Alva awarded for Story Writing Competition


Mst. Dhanvish Alva Grade VI of our school has been awarded for the Short Story Writing Competition 2020 organised by ISF Institute of Research and Education.






