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


## India's Top Prestigious School Jury Awards 2021 - ( Jury's choice Award ) for our school

17th School Anniversary celebrations were indeed a show of talent and attraction not only for the students but for the entire school. The virtual celebrations display was enjoyed by all.




**Show and Tell activity**
